Join this very interesting and educational seminar as Dr. Daniel Sheridan, PhD, RN, FAAN discusses techniques in identifying causes of abuse and neglect. Dr. Sheridan will discuss a multitude of forensic techniques that will help you be able to get to the root cause of incidents occurring in your facility and determine whether these incidents constitute an intentional act or were accidental in nature. In addition to educating you on how to determine the cause of an incident, he will discuss effective documentation of findings both written and photographic.

Speaker: Daniel J. Sheridan, PhD, RN, FAAN is a Professor at the Texas A&M College of Nursing in Bryan, Texas where he is the Director of its Forensic Health Care Education, Research, and Intervention Program. He completed his PhD in Nursing at the Oregon Health Sciences University School of Nursing in 1998. Dr. Sheridan retired in 2013 as an Associate Professor after teaching 12 years at Johns Hopkins University School of Nursing, where he developed forensic nursing courses at the baccalaureate, master's and doctoral degree levels. He is internationally certified as a sexual assault nurse examiner (SANE-A).

Dr. Sheridan has taught in several doctoral level online education programs and has developed numerous online forensic health care-related courses nationally and internationally. Dr. Sheridan is a former board member of the National Committee for the Prevention of Elder Abuse and a former Board President of the International Association of Forensic Nurses. He has published more than 35 clinical and research articles on nursing's role in abuse and forensics and has given over 600 invited lectures on these topics nationally and internationally.

Dr. Sheridan has over 30 years of clinical and research experience working with intimate partner violence, sexual assault, vulnerable person abuse and neglect, bruising, injury identification and strangulation.
