The federal regulations require that each facility have an infection prevention and control system that is consistent with national guidelines and standards of practice for preventing, identifying, reporting, investigating and controlling the spread of infection. This program addresses these new regulations including how to implement the surveillance system; how to use surveillance data to drive decision making; reviews nationally recognized guidelines for when and how isolation precautions should be used for a resident and discusses criteria for decision-making on when to discontinue isolation; provides instruction on how to conduct an infection control risk assessment; provides information on environmental cleaning and disinfection; and discusses key strategies to support antibiotic stewardship. This seminar is designed to cover topics that will assist facilities in preventing infections and developing an infection control program that will help meet current regulatory compliance for **SPECIALIZED** Training for the Long Term Care Infection Preventionist.
