Course Description: This course will review ICD-10-CM coding conventions & official guidelines for coding and reporting to gain knowledge on appropriately assigning ICD-10 codes. It also will go over upcoming code changes impacting the nursing facility setting, with a focus on the diagnosis codes that impact reimbursement under the Patient Driven Payment Model (PDPM) taking effect October 1, 2019.

- Understand how ICD-10 coding will impact reimbursement under Medicare PDPM

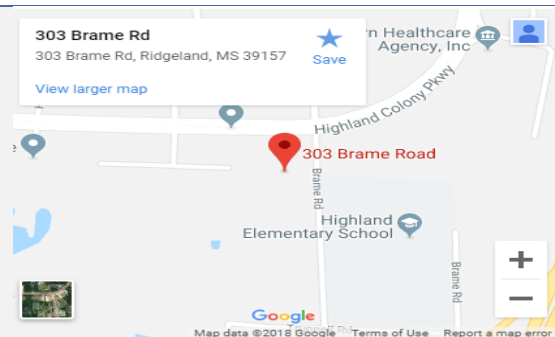
