From I-20 West and I-55 North. Take Exit 475 toward Intl Airport / Pearl. In approximately 4.8 miles turn left onto Lakeland Drive / Hwy 25. In approximately 3 miles turn right onto Ridgewood Road. Just past Eastwood Drive turn left at the sign that reads "Education and Research Center." Once you turn into the Education and Research Center go the first stop sign and turn left. Then turn right into the third drive which leads to a parking lot. Signs will be posted.

From I-55 South you can take the above route or take Exit 100 towards Northside Drive / Meadowbrook Road. Merge onto I 55 Frontage Road North. Continue on I-55 Frontage Road North toward McComb / Meadowbrook Road. At Meadowbrook Road turn left. In approximately 0.8 miles turn right onto Ridgewood Road. In approximately 0.7 miles turn right at the sign that reads "Education and Research Center." Once you turn into the Education and Research Center go the first stop sign and turn left. Then turn right into the third drive which leads to a parking lot. Signs will be posted.

Person-Centered Care Plans

August 10, 2018

Presentation: Since the new CMS survey process has gone into effect, deficiencies in "person-centered care" have been routinely cited in most facilities. The basis for individualized care revolves around, and is directed by, the resident's comprehensive care plan. This one document causes more frustration, confusion, and concern than almost any other piece of documentation. Who is involved? How is it written? How do we make the plan "individualized," especially when utilizing computer-generated plans? And, ultimately, what are surveyor's expectations in this area? Join Cat as she explains the easy process of developing an individualized, person-centered care plan for each resident. She will be addressing the comprehensive care plan process, as well as the process for the development of the 48-hour baseline care plan. Cat will share surveyor focus and trends in current citations. Cat continues to train state agencies (surveyors) in this area and is considered an authority in the care plan process.
