Quality reporting has become increasingly important for nursing facilities. Consumers can now use publicly reported quality measures and the 5-Star rating program to evaluate your facility when choosing care settings for their loved ones. Quality measure performance drives the survey process. Quality measures already effect Medicare reimbursement rates through the Value Based Purchasing (VBP) program. Many facilities understand how assessments effect their case mix scores and reimbursement, but are less familiar with how assessments are used in calculating quality measures or strategies for improvement. Join us for this training to learn how to navigate these quality programs.
